Pursuant to statute, the filing period is now open for two Director positions in the Quincy-Columbia Basin Irrigation District (Divisions 1 and 2). To serve as a Director, the individual must be 18 years of age, a US citizen and a resident of Washington State. A Director must hold title to land within the District and Director Division they wish to represent. See also *District Election Guidelines* at QCBID.org

Steve Omlin is the incumbent Director of Division 1, which includes all of Range 23, and that portion of Range 24 lying West of Highway 281 and South to the Frenchman Hills.

John Rylaarsdam is the incumbent Director of Division 2, which includes all that portion of Range 24 lying East of Highway 281 and South to the Frenchman Hills.

To file for the position of Director, a complete Petition of Nomination, signed by at least 10 qualified voters in that Director Division, must be filed in the Quincy District office by 5:00 PM on Monday, November 6, 2023. The candidacy Petition of Nomination may be obtained by calling the Quincy District main office in Quincy at 509-787-3591, the main office is located at 1720 S Central Ave, Quincy.

Anyone wanting information regarding the Director Division they are eligible to vote in, please call the Quincy office at 509-787-3591.
