APPLICATION FOR AND CONSENT TO COMBINE WATER RECORDS AND WATER DELIVERIES

This application to combine the water records and water deliveries is submitted with the understanding that, if consent thereto is given, it will be subject to the following rules, regulations and stipulations:

1. Applications for combinations must be submitted by the operator each year.
2. A \$25.00 non-refundable fee shall accompany each application to cover handling costs.
3. Deadline for submitting applications is the last business day of May. Applications submitted on June 1 to the last business day of July shall bear a \$100 late charge. No application will be accepted after the last business day of July.
4. All lands in combination must be on the same ditchride.
5. Portions:
 - A. A portion(s) must be included in combination if receiving water.
 - B. If a portion receives water through the headgate located on another portion of the unit both portions must be listed on the combination.
 - C. A portion(s) not receiving water may or may not be included in the combination.
 - D. Portion(s) not receiving water or isolated portions cannot be included unless the assessment is paid by the operator.
6. All lands in combination must be operated by one operator unless in common delivery. If in common delivery only the designated operator on this combination will be recognized as the operator.
7. Special water service contracts cannot be combined with the exception of temporary productive.
8. For determining peak delivery capacity during times of proration, combinations may be applied only to units and/or portions of units serviced by the same lateral provided capacity is available as determined in the sole and exclusive discretion of the District.
9. An operator may sign the application for the owner unless the owner has filed written exception to the signing. If the operator signs for the owner, the operator assumes full responsibility for combinations.
10. A combination may be broken only if a new operator is in possession of the land and both parties agree and sign off on the original combination plus a \$250.00 fee, _____
11. In order to control excess water usage on a per unit basis in accordance with the excess water policy (adopted 9/2/14), any unit receiving over four and a half feet (4.5) per acre excess will be automatically dropped from the combination. Any prior purchase will remain with the combination and purchase will be adjusted in accordance with applicable rates after excess unit(s) are separated.
12. All assessments on units in combination must be paid and RRA paperwork completed. If any are unpaid or RRA paperwork is not in by the deadline, the combination will not be approved.
