

AQUATIC HERBICIDE NOTIFICATION REGISTRATION

The Quincy-Columbia Basin Irrigation District treats canals for aquatic weed and algae control with copper sulfate, acrolein, and endothall.

Individuals who desire advanced notice of aquatic herbicide treatments, such as organic producers must **submit annual written notice** to the District.

We want to make this information available to you in a timely manner so you can best manage your water.

The copper sulfate is certified by the Organic Materials Review Institute. A copy of the OMRI certificate is available at <https://www.qcbid.org/index.php/about-qcbid/water-quality>.

If you are an organic producer, please refer to your certification requirements on whether or not you need to turn your water off during treatments.
