Subject: 2022 Global Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) Program Criteria Requirements

Dear Mr. Sonnichsen:

The Bureau of Reclamation requests that farmers within the Columbia Basin Project (CBP) and who are part of the GAP Program be given the *Integrated Farm Assurance All Farm Base-Crops Base-Fruit and Vegetables Control Points and Compliance Criteria*; Version 5.0, Edition 5.0-1_February 2016; page 47 of 143; Section CB.5.4 requirements.

The narrative that follows should substantiate the individual farmer's right to use the irrigation water for their crops that is supplied by Reclamation and the CBP Districts.

The United States, acting through Reclamation, holds the water rights for the CBP. Landowners are authorized to apply Columbia Basin Project water pursuant to water-related contracts with Reclamation, contingent upon the filing of required Reclamation Reform Act of 1982 documentation and payment of the current years' assessment.
